BOONE, NC: Community members and the Appalachian State University Office of Sustainability are collaborating to host the 2018 Trash Fashion show on April 22 in the HOW Space located at 182 Howard Street. Children under 12 years of age may enter for free and donations of \$5 for students and \$10 for adults are encouraged. All proceeds will benefit the In/Visible Theatre and the Western Youth Network.

Trash Fashion is a community movement that emphasizes the repurposing of goods considered to be no longer useful, unwanted or disposable into fashionable garments. The event will be broken into different segments starting with creative activities for children such as facepainting and trash art at 4:30 p.m., the first fashion show at 5:30 p.m., the second fashion show at 6:30 p.m. Everyone is invited for an after party across the street at the Local.

The In/Visible Theatre is a non-profit acting company located in Boone, NC. It was established in 2012 and continues to provide exposure for unheard voices through producing work that challenges audiences to see, hear, and experience the world in new ways.
